Registration at Host Headquarters: Please note that competitors in this sport are REQUIRED to register with the Host and receive their accreditation by, at the least, the day before the beginning of competition.

GUIDING BODY: World Police & Fire Games Federation and the Association Internationale de Boxe Amateur (AIBA).

EQUIPMENT & REQUIREMENTS: MEN'S & WOMEN'S BOXING: No person who has fought in any professional bout or exhibition shall be allowed to compete in WPFG Boxing. SAFETY RULE: No entries shall be accepted from applicants who are 36 years of age or older as of the opening date of the Games (31 July). Absolutely NO exceptions.

MEN'S DIVISIONS; NOVICE: shall not have fought in more than 5 amateur bouts. INTERMEDIATE DIVISION: shall have fought in no more than 10 amateur bouts. Boxers who do not qualify as Novice or Intermediate shall enter the OPEN DIVISION.

WOMEN'S DIVISION: OPEN (Only)

ABOUT ATTIRE: Boxers shall be suitably attired. Footwear shall be

boxing/wrestling shoes. Fitted boxing trunks, and one red and one blue jersey/singlet are required. Personal mouth and groin protection is mandatory. Female boxers shall provide their own chest protector to be worn during all bouts. All other mandatory equipment will be provided by the Host, including 12 oz. (340 gram) thumbless gloves.

WEIGH-IN: Weigh-ins take place the day before competition begins. You must attempt to make the weight listed on the Sports Entry Form, but you will compete at your weight at weigh-in. Attendance is required for all participants at a clinic/orientation with Boxing officials following Weigh-ins. Confirmation Letter will provide details.

MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS: All Boxers are required to submit a medical examination form, signed by a licensed physician, prior to or during Host Registration in British Columbia. It must be current (within 6 months of Games' date) and may take one of two forms:

1) The World Police and Fire Games

"Report of Physical Examination". The form will be sent upon receipt of your completed Sports Entry Form, or may be obtained by request to the San Diego office or, is available for download as a PDF from www.2009wpfg.ca.

2) The AIBA "Competition Record Book for Boxers." **IMPORTANT:** If you are using the AIBA booklet, you must: a) Submit copies of page 1 and the page with the record of your MOST RECENT "Annual Medical Examination" (dated within 6 months of the Games) prior to or during Host Headquarters Registration; and, b) have the original booklet in your possession at the time of weigh-in for review by fight officials.

No applicant shall be allowed to register, weigh-in, or compete in boxing without having submitted proper medical clearance as outlined above.

BRACKETING: Single Elimination. Three 2-minute rounds. The draw shall take place after the medical review and weigh-in at the mandatory meeting. If there are over 8 boxers in the same class and weight division, "A & B" divisions will be created and a second set of medals awarded. If two competitors from the same department are listed together in the first round, they will be matched with other competitors, if possible. All subsequent rounds will be per bracket eliminations.

AGE & WEIGHT CATEGORIES: Open; 18-35 ONLY. Weight divisions are in Kilograms as per AIBA rules.

APPROXIMATE weights in pounds are provided below as a convenience for some competitors. Weigh-ins will be conducted in Kilograms only. (One Kilogram = 2.205 Pounds)
