**Registration at Host Headquarters:** Please note that competitors in this sport are REQUIRED to register with the Host and receive their accreditation by, at the least, the day before the beginning of competition.

**GUIDING BODIES:** World Police & Fire Games Federation and World Taekwondo Federation (WTF)

**EQUIPMENT & REQUIREMENTS:** All competitors shall hold a Taekwondo Dan certificate issued by the Kukkiwon/WTF. All personal equipment shall be provided by the entrant. Competitors will be attired in a Taekwondo uniform; and protection, as recognized by the WTF, before entering the contest area. Protection shall consist of the trunk protector, head protector, groin guard, forearm and shin guards. The groin guard, forearm and shin guards shall be worn inside

the Taekwondo uniform.

Prior to or during Host Headquarters Registration, all competitors must submit a Medical Release, signed by a licensed physician and based on a physical exam conducted within 6 months of competition.

This release may take the form of a doctor's note stating the entrant's fitness to compete in a contact sport.

Weigh-ins will take place the day prior to competition. You must enter in your estimated competition weight however; you will compete at your weight at weigh-in or the next heaviest class available.

While ultimately, the competition schedule depends upon the number of competitors and their weight/age distribution, a tentative competition schedule will be included with the Confirmation Letter.

**BRACKETING:** Single elimination brackets are used to determine the two athletes who will compete in the final match for first and second place. The repechage bracket is built by selecting all of the athletes who were knocked out by the finalist and building brackets to determine third place.

The duration of the contest shall be 3 rounds of 2 minutes each with one minute of rest between rounds. For Finals: 3 rounds of 2 minutes.

Gold and Silver medalist will be determined as per single elimination format. Bronze medalist will be determined using Repechage.

Note: There will be 2 bronze medalists for each division.

**AGE & WEIGHT CATEGORIES:** Open [18-29]; Senior [30-39]; Master [40- 49]; and, Grand Master [50+]. Weight divisions are in Kilograms as per WTF rules. APPROXIMATE weights in pounds are provided below as a convenience for some competitors. Weigh-ins will be conducted in Kilograms only. (One Kilogram = 2.205 Pounds)
